INPATIENT CARE

The Morrison's Dana Rehabilitation Wing has private or shared rooms, where patients can recover from strokes, heart attacks, hip and knee replacements, back injuries and other medical procedures that require a long- or short-term stay. Rehabilitative services are offered six days a week.



Patients receive Skilled Nursing Care, along with Physical and Occupational Therapy and Speech Pathology from our team of licensed therapists. Our individualized care plans focus on restoring, maximizing and promoting the overall fitness and health of each patient to promote the best quality of life possible.

OUTPATIENT CARE

The Morrison offers all of the services listed below on an outpatient basis at the Morrison. The Rehabilitation Team utilizes a broad array of therapies to assist patients in achieving their goals of health and fitness so they can resume as many of their regular activities as possible following surgery or other medical events requiring outpatient care.

Physical Therapy

Our Physical Therapists employ a variety of state-of-the-art equipment to help restore function, improve mobility, relieve pain, and prevent or limit permanent physical disabilities.

Occupational Therapy

Our Occupational Therapists work with patients with the goal of ensuring they can perform the everyday tasks necessary for their return home, such as feeding, grooming, bathing and dressing.

Speech Pathology

Our Speech Pathologist diagnoses and treats speech and swallowing disorders following strokes, head injuries, intubation, and any event where the patient has weakened throat muscles and needs training in safe swallowing and recovering speech.
