ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

- Participants in the apprenticeship are full-time employees of **The Morrison Skilled Nursing Home** from the start of the program
- Receive tuition scholarship to offset training cost, and eligible for additional grant funding for support services
- Receive pay increases as they meet milestones throughout the program
- Receive 2,000 hours of on-the-job training with a mentor

AND MORE!

- 144 hours of paid classroom instruction time at **White Mountains Community College in Littleton**, which includes theory, lab work, and a clinical practicum.
- At completion, students will be able to sit for the state certification exam and submit their LNA license application to the NH Board of Nursing
- At successful completion of the program, apprentices continue their employment at **The Morrison Skilled Nursing Home**
